CARROLL ISD SCHOOL SAFETY & SECURITY COMMITTEE
August 12, 2021

The Carroll ISD School Safety and Security Committee meeting was called to order at approximately 4:04 p.m. at the Carroll ISD Administration Center, 2400 N. Carroll Avenue, Southlake, Texas, by Asst. Superintendent for Staff and Student Services, Gordon Butler.

The meeting began with a brief welcome to the committee members.

Topics of discussion included how children need to be re-oriented to the classroom after last year; concern about cybersecurity as it relates to students (social media awareness, etc.); making sure security is consistent district-wide (locking building doors, man traps, security cameras); and possibly scheduling safety drills during cafeteria lunch times.
